Parish Communities: Agents of Faith, Hope, Love

This weekend we celebrate Catechetical Sunday. The celebration this year will be different from ones in the past, as we continue to face the threat of the Covid-19 pandemic. We will not be able to have the commissioning and commitment ceremony for the catechists of the parish. Regardless of the situation ahead of us or the circumstances that unfolds before us, the mission of the parish continues. Parish programs, meetings as we aware are now mainly held *via* social media and other online means. As for the Sunday School formation, it is truly an occasion for the parish today as Sunday Catechism classes begins today *via* the various online platforms.

The theme for this year's Catechetical Sunday is Parish communities: Agents of Faith, Hope and Love. The message highlights the significance of belonging to a parish community and how each of us as members of the community respond as agents of Faith, Hope and Love. God never intended for us to live alone. He calls us to share, serve, heal, work, and worship in and with our communities. Captivated by God's mercy, we respond generously to God's call whenever we gather as a community to celebrate the Holy Eucharist and to participate in parish activities. Being an imperfect people, as a community, we too face challenges, constantly struggling with human weaknesses and threatened by opposing forces. Together as a community, we need to build the parish through our words and deeds, because we play a vital role in the task of evangelization.

The fundamental virtues of Faith, Hope and Love are the foundation to every Christian life (1 Corinthians 13: 13). As members of the parish community, we should clothe ourselves in Christ (Galatian 3:27), with the virtues of faith and love as a breastplate and our hope of salvation as a helmet (1 Thessalonians 5:8), so as to glorify God and be in communion with each other. We must humble ourselves to practice and cultivate these virtues in order to bear fruit. We must not be influenced by worldly values which are damaging to the parish

community. To live the virtues of Faith, Hope and Love, we need to imitate Mother Mary and allow the Holy Spirit to make good use of us as instruments of love and peace.

As leaders and members of the parish community, we must uphold these virtues, else we may be consumed with pride, self-righteousness, dissatisfaction, jealousy and become judgmental of others; We may be blinded by our own shortcomings, which may lead to division and intolerance toward each other.

As agents of Faith, Hope and Love, we must not take our role for granted. We should each do our small part and strive to be the "salt of the earth and the light of the world" (Matthew 5:13-16) in our daily life. Let us start by seeing Christ in others, and also by being Christ to them; bringing joy, healing and restoration to all. "Not all of us can do great things. But we can do small things with great love." (Saint Teresa of Calcutta). And now faith, hope and love abide, these three; and the greatest of these is love" (1 Corinthians 13:13).
