PARISH PRIEST SPEAKS

Lord Jesus, open the Scriptures to us; make our hearts burn while you speak to us

In our journey through life, we are often confronted with several problems and difficulties which can make us at times lose our perspective. We can lose all direction to life and remain helpless. Then left to ourselves we become nothing and tend to remain with uncertainty. In such situations we need positive support, a sincere understanding which can place us on the right path.

We have with us this week another account of Jesus appearing to his disciples on Easter Sunday. The gospel begins with the story of the two disciples who had the experience of walking with Jesus and their recognition of the Lord in the breaking of bread. Jesus remaining close to them drives away all their doubts and unbelief by giving them the gift of peace. He asks the disciples to touch and feel him and experience his real presence among them. He remains as the real friend in their lives, and helps them back into confidence.

What is significant from the readings and reflection is the urgency again and again for us to believe. We are in the midst of the Easter Season, in which we celebrate for seven weeks Jesus' glorious Resurrection from the dead. It is a real challenge for us to believe in the Resurrection. It was difficult enough for us to take in the contradiction of Jesus dving on the Cross. We know that all men die, but how can this dying man be God, the Creator of the universe? How can God die, and in such a horrible way, humiliated, abandoned and mocked? And then we see his body laid in the tomb, dead. But now this dead body has been raised back to life! It would be a wonderful story to inspire us to hope in spite of any hardships. But that is not what our faith says. This is not a story made up to inspire us. It actually happened.

It was at this juncture that the Lord convinces the Apostles that he is real and alive, he takes two further steps with them. First, he builds up their understanding of the meaning of what has happened. This process is summarized in the wonderful verse, "Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures." Secondly, he sends them forth as his witnesses, to preach the Gospel to all nations.

He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures! This is what the Lord is doing for us as we pause to ponder the word. We believe that he is risen, but we still long for deeper understanding of his Risen Life in us. We can be confident that the Lord gives us this understanding as he "opens our minds." This gift in turn prepares us for our mission of sharing the Good News with others.

As I ponder the Word, do I experience a longing for a deeper understanding of Jesus' Risen Life in me? Even as I profess that I am a sinner. do I have the hope that Jesus is always merciful to me? Do I have the habit of praising God for his great mercy toward me?


