PARISH PRIEST SPEAKS

"This is my commandment: love one another as I love you." (John 15:12)

The command of Jesus to his disciples is simply to "Remain in my love." In the context of his teaching Jesus steps deeper into the teaching by explaining how we are to remain in his love: "If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love." Acting uprightly then, means keeping Christ's commandments. The Lord is not speaking about a burdensome set of moral obligations. He is directing us in his own way, the way of love. When we love God and love our neighbor, we put into practice the covenant that he has made with us - and so we remain in his love.

"This is my commandment: love one another as I love you." Loving one another as he loves us means desiring and working for the salvation of the other. The teachings of the saints reveal to us that to love someone is to will the good of the person loved. The highest good that we can will for anyone is that they enter into the fullness of life in union with God. This is "eternal life"; this is the salvation that Jesus has won for us by becoming an "explation for our sins." When we will the good of the other, when we desire and work for their salvation, we put ourselves in the realm of God; we participate in the life of God who is Love. This is what it means to "act uprightly." It is the way of life most "acceptable to God" because it is his own way, his own love, at work in us.

In our effort to keep the commandment of loving one another as Christ loves us, it is important that we pay attention to "as he loves us." "As he loves us" is the standard of our love. Our love will only bear fruit if we are united with him, following his way. For this reason, we need to seek him in prayer and allow ourselves to be formed and transformed by him. The Catechism of the Church explains the profound link between prayer and love: "Contemplative prayer seeks him 'whom my soul loves.' It is Jesus, and in him, the Father. We seek him, because to desire him is always the beginning of love, and we seek him in that pure faith which causes us to be born of him and to live in him" (CCC 2709). From our union with Love comes forth our love for one another. To draw nearer to the One who is Love draws us into a bond of love with all those whom he loves.

How can this love which the Risen Lord gives us be shared with others? Jesus has many times pointed out to us who the "other" to love is, not with words but with actions. It is the person I encounter on the street and who, with his face and his story, challenges me: it is the one who, with his very presence, compels me to leave my interests and my certainties behind; it is he who awaits my willingness to listen and to walk a stretch of road together. This is the expression of the face of mercy that is mirrored in our encounter and relationships with others. Openness towards each brother and sister, whoever they may be and whatever their situation, beginning with those who are close to me in the family, in the community, at work, at school.... In this way, if I remain united to Jesus, his love can reach the other and draw him to it, to his friendship.

Am I remaining in the love of Jesus by keeping his commandments? Is it my areat desire and will for everyone to enter into the fullness of life in union with God? Do I seek him in that pure faith which causes me to be born of him and to live in him?
