But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

Acts 1:8

Pentecost day is the birthday of the Church. On the day of Pentecost, the Holy Spirit descended with power upon the Apostles in the form of tongues of fire and thus began the mission of the Church in the world. Once they received the Spirit, they went out boldly and preached to all in Jerusalem and elsewhere. Jesus himself prepared the Eleven for this mission, appearing to them on many occasions after his Resurrection. He gave them their The feast of Pentecost is culminated with the sending of mission: "As the Father has sent me, so I sent you."

We too share the same mission as the Disciples. He then breathed on them just as God breathed on the earth and created the first human being. The breathing also symbolizes the Spirit of God and of Jesus. He said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit." It was the Spirit who raised Jesus from the dead. It was the Spirit who opened the minds of his disciples and helped them understand the meaning of His death. When He was raised up to glory at the right hand of the Father, Jesus poured out the Spirit descended on the apostles, individually and collectively. to preach, reconcile and to heal. Filled with the Holy Spirit, they began their mission. It is the same Spirit that descends on us at our Baptism and Confirmation. The Spirit is not given for a moment but accompanies us on our journey in the footsteps of Jesus. The Spirit gives us power to participate in the work of Jesus in our daily life.

St. Paul talks about the fruits of the Spirit (Gal 5:22):

Firstly, Wisdom - desire for the things of God, and to direct our whole life and all our actions to His honour and glory. Here we see God at work in our lives and in the

Second, **Understanding** – enables us to know more clearly the mysteries of faith. It perfects a person's speculative reason in the apprehension of truth.

Third, Counsel - warns us of the deceits of the evil one, and of the dangers to salvation. With the gift of right judgment, we know the difference between right and wrong, and we choose to do what is right.

Fourth, Fortitude (courage) – With the gift of courage, we overcome our fear and are willing to take risks as a follower of Jesus Christ. It strengthens us to do the will of God in all things.

Fifth, **Knowledge** – With the gift of knowledge, the Spirit enables us to discover the will of God in all things.

Sixth, Piety (Reverence) - With the gift of reverence, sometimes called piety, we have a deep sense of respect for God and the church.

The seventh gift, Fear of the Lord (awe of God) – With the gift of wonder, prayerful respect and awe we are aware of the glory and majesty of God. A person with such awe and wonder has perfect knowledge, perfect goodness, perfect power, and perfect love.

the Spirit of the Father and the Son on His disciples. This feast indicates the extraordinary intervention of God into our lives by which Jesus makes us partakers in the mystery of the Trinity. The feast of Pentecost indicates that it is an on-going reality, which still touches our lives every single day. Let us reflect upon the purpose of the Holy Spirit in the Church that guides and teaches us according to the purpose for which He has been sent. Through the power of the Spirit, we ask for the grace to be forgiven and the grace to forgive others. Today Jesus on those who were to carry on His mission.
