Embracing the Word of God is literally holding the Word of God close to your heart. Embracing the Word is first step to realise that the Word of God is indeed Jesus. That is why we use the term "embracing" because we literally embrace Jesus! When "Jesus" the Word, is read out aloud, we are making way for Jesus to come into our lives, into our difficult situations, so that He is able take over completely. That's how literal it is!

There is a banner that hangs in our Church and it quotes Jeremiah 15:16, "Your words were found, and I ate them, and your words became to me a joy and the delight of my heart; for I am called by your name, O LORD, God of hosts." Surely there is a question popping in your head: How do we eat the Word of God let alone embrace the Word of God? Well, when we have taken the first step towards understanding that the Word of God is indeed Jesus and Jesus is the Bread of Life, something happens. When we read out aloud the Word of God, our faith rises as promised in Romans 10:17, "So faith comes from what is heard, and what is heard comes through the word of Christ." Then, we begin to experience His assurance that we would not want to let go and literally embrace it as long as we can. His Words become such solace to our hearts that "His peace which surpasses all understanding will guard our hearts and minds in Jesus". (Phil 4:7)

Peter states that "the word of the Lord stands forever" (1 Pet. 1:25). Each time we open the Word of the Lord and allow it to penetrate our life, we are placing something eternal within us. Allowing the Word to move us makes us want to "embrace" and not let go because the world is not able to give us that peace that we long for so much.

Last month we were reminded to dwell in the Word of God. When we dwell in something, we tend to get close to it and we will not want to let go, especially when it's real & alive! Same goes for the Word. When we dwell in the Word of God, we will fall in love with Him because His Word is alive. In Heb 4:12, it says, "Indeed, the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing until it divides soul from spirit, joints from marrow; it is able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart."

WHY do we need to embrace the Word of God?

- The Word of God builds us in our Soul (Mind, Emotions & Will)
- The Word of God strengthens us when we are weak
- The Word of God is near to our lips so we can speak it anytime
- The Word of God increases faith in times of trouble

It is similar to reminding God of His promises to us! When God hears us, He is so pleased because we, like Moses, took God by His word and God answered his plea. Today, we are like Moses, standing in the gap for our families and community.

WHAT are benefits in embracing the Word of God?

- **Protects** us from harm and danger
- Increases faith as we persevere
- Gain wisdom to run our daily work
- Experience extraordinary blessings
- Assist us to overcome sin & walk in faithfulness
- Experience peace of mind & freedom in mind & body

HOW to embrace the Word of God: -

- Believe in the Scriptures. Believe what God has spoken in the Scripture
- *Memorise* a short verse that touched your heart and confess it throughout the day. Make it your favourite verse.
- If you do not believe, just *say a prayer* asking God to give you the faith to believe in His Word.
- Continue to *ponder or meditate* on the Word of God eg. If you are in fear, read Isaiah 41:10 *loudly* and *believe*. The keyword is "believe."
- Personalise the scriptures and make it your personal prayer. Change the "You" to "I" eg." Isa 41:10 Fear not, for I am with you" change it to "I will not fear, for God is with "me."
- Capture His word into your heart. Repeat the promises of God over and over again throughout the day until it gets rooted in your heart.

The secret behind embracing the Word of God is believing every word He has spoken and making it yours and yours alone. We will experience His peace in the midst of our storm and we will be able to move one day at time, in His strength. We were never meant to be in this storm alone. That is why embracing "JESUS" who is the "WORD" is our only way out!
