MINISTRY SHOUTOUT OF THE MONTH:

EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION (EMHC)

During the celebration of the Eucharist, the distribution of Holy Communion is done by the ordinary ministers, namely bishops, priests, and deacons (Canon Law 910.1). If such ordinary ministers of Holy Communion is not sufficient due to the size of the congregation, the priest may call upon extraordinary ministers to assist him.



"When the need of the Church warrants it and ministers are lacking, lay persons even if they are not lectors or acolytes, can also supply certain of their duties, namely, to exercise the ministry of the word, to preside over liturgical prayers, to confer baptism, and to distribute Holy Communion, according to the prescripts of the law." (Canon Law 230.3)

Besides assisting the priest during Holy Communion, the roles of these Communion Ministers also extend to giving Communion to homebound parishioners and play a major part during Corpus Christi.



TESTIMONIALS OF MERCY



So faith, hope, love remain, these three: but the greatest of these is love. - 1 Corinthians 13:13

The Gospel today picks up where we left off last Sunday. Jesus is in the synagogue of his native town of Nazareth, where he has read a passage from the scroll of Isaiah. After the reading, he sits down and makes an astounding claim, that this very passage, a prophecy of the Messiah, "is fulfilled as you listened. Jesus goes on to tell the people that "no prophet is accepted in his own native place." In saying this, he is identifying himself as a prophet, thus revealing that he will not subject himself to their expectations. A prophet does not answer to popular demands; rather, he answers to God, the one who sends him. A prophet is not accepted, even by the very people to whom he is sent, precisely because he speaks in the name of God, not in the name of the king or the culture or the clan. Jesus is building on the tradition of the great prophets Elijah and Elisha, who did what God sent them to do, and brought divine aid even to foreigners.

The violent reaction of the people of Nazareth in the Gospel shows us why a prophet needs such a powerful defense response from the Lord. When they hear Jesus imply that their ideas about their exclusive rank before God are too narrow and selfish, their anger boils over. God gives Jesus the same consolation that he provided for Jeremiah. He does not leave his prophet "crushed on their account, as though I would leave you crushed before them." Instead, "Jesus passed through the midst of them and went away."

St. Paul in today's second reading teaches us what genuine familiarity with God brings about in us, a transformation of our life through love. He says that he used to "talk as a child, think as a child, reason as a child", referring to his former way of life, when he was like the self-righteous Nazarene. But when he met Jesus Christ, he realized he had to put his childish self - centeredness aside. Love chooses what is good for the other. Love is not primarily focused on the grand things we can do, such as speaking in human and angelic tongues, uttering prophecies, or moving mountains. These are good, but if in doing them we are focused on ourselves rather than on others, then they are without true value. Paul says, "If I do not have love, I am nothing... I gain nothing."

St. Paul's famous hymn to love, then, gives a precious instruction to anyone who is serious about the life of faith, anyone who is dedicated to growing ever more familiar with God. We may be intent on speaking quality time pondering the word of God and entering daily into the liturgical life of the Church. This is all good. But we need to examine deeply whether this familiarity with the Lord is just making us more self-centred and selfrighteous. The familiarity that the Lord desires with us is not only about us. It must make us more other-centred. The evidence of genuine maturity is the growth of faith, hope, and love and, as St. Paul says, "the greatest of these

How do I react when I hear others speak the truth? When do I become too familiar with God that I start to impose my expectations on him? As I come to know the Lord more, how am I becoming other-centred?
