"Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him" - John 14:2

We step into the 6th Sunday of Easter with the words of which we face throughout the day. Jesus to the disciples, "Whoever loves me will keep my Word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him." These words and teachings are instructed to his disciples and to us today. We often think that if we keep God's Word, with the help of his grace, then we will eventually come to dwell with him in Heaven.
