### PARISH PRIEST SPEAKS ....

#### "Today salvation has come to this house... the Son of Man has come to seek and to save what was lost." -Luke 19:10

The God who reveals Himself to us, in whom we believe and whom we worship, is a God of mercy. All the revelations of God that we have in scriptures and in tradition, bear witness to this. God in His mercy desires our salvation. The readings and reflections this weekend from the Book of Wisdom and from the Gospel of Luke are all about God's mercy and our salvation.

The reading from Wisdom begins by extolling the greatness of God, who created all things for His glory and before whom the whole universe is like a grain of sand or a drop of morning dew. God looks on us with mercy as the text narrates. "You have mercy on all, because you can do all things and you overlook people's sins that they may repent". It is the reminder to abandon their wickedness and to believe in God. God's gentle correction of a sinner who then abandons his wickedness is what we see in today's Gospel account of the encounter between our Lord Jesus and the tax collector, Zacchaeus. God is His infinite mercy always desires to meet us and to let is taste and enjoy His goodness.

The gospel text does not tell us what motivated Zacchaeus, but the fact that he risked humiliation and ridicule by climbing a tree indicates an unabashed and determination to dogged see the Lord.
