## **Easter Story**

They walked away amazed & bewildered! Mary sees Jesus in the garden and assumes He is a gardener. And He finally reveals Himself to her.

Now back to 2022, ask yourself this one question: *Why did Jesus appear to Mary Mag'dalene?* Mary was important to Jesus & He trusted her. Jesus knew that Mary will know what to do with this information. Jesus trusted her with this news because she will faithfully bring this news to disciples, who

then brought it into the world.

There are 2 things that we need to know at this Easter;

- 1) Just like Mary Mag'dalene, we are important to Jesus
- 2) Jesus trusts us with His Story

Brothers & sisters, Jesus has proven to us repeatedly that He is a God who came looking for us, who came and reached out to us so that we may encounter Him in our daily walk in this world today. There are some of us who are still in the dark of who this Jesus is. Some of us here have not encountered the Jesus of Mary Mag'delene.

The question that we should consider asking ourselves:

- a) Are we ready to tell His story to all those we meet every day?
- b) Are we ready to share His love story to someone who may not know who Jesus is in the first place?
- c) Are we ready to tell the story as it is to our children?

## Let's ponder & discuss:

What are the various challenges or obstacles that hinders or stops you from sharing a mercy story with a friend or relative?

Now that we have shared our various obstacles & hindrances that stops us from sharing our story, let us look on how we are able to rise above these obstacles the godly way.

Today, the Lord is reminding each one of us, that we are important to Him. Jesus trusts us with His stories. God has conquered the grave for us. We, too, have stories of our own. Our experiences with Jesus, are stories that we must share to someone who does not know Jesus. There are so many out there who do not even know that they need Jesus to get through life! It's so sad, right?

This Easter, because we believe in him, he comes to us first as well, and he tells us to go spread the Good News to the rest of the world

## We are on a Mission-Story

Today, we are invited to share our mercy stories with one another, Christians or non-Christian family and friends. These stories stem from 2 things:

- i) Relationship with God
- ii) Relationship with Your community

Jesus has risen from the dead and He has entrusted this information to us so that we can do something with that information. God believes that His story will transform your heart by the Holy Spirit. God has been on a mission from the first day of creation till today. Our lives have become a mission field where His Mercy story becomes alive! Our lives tell a story to anyone who encounters us.

### How do I share a Mercy Story?



#### 1. SHARE ONE OF MY FAVOURITE BIBLE STORIES

Every week we listen to the Gospel proclaimed by the priest. We listen to his sermons attentively. Then we walk out of the church, we go for breakfast with friends & family. What better time to share an excerpt from the Gospel or the sermon and talk about it? **Share your experience** on how you felt when the Gospel was being proclaimed. Allow the Spirit to excite you!



# 2. SHARE A PERSONAL TESTIMONY OF GOD'S MERCY IN MY LIFE

We pray all the time. When we are in need, we pray when are in pain or sick, etc. After praying so much, we get well or we received an answer that we have been waiting for! So how did this miracle come about? It cannot be a co-incidence because you had done something right: **YOU PRAYED**. So, truth is, your prayer has been answered. Now, you have **ONE** story in your hands. Tell it to whoever you meet!



#### 3. LIVE MY LIFE ROOTED IN JESUS

We prayed and our prayers were answered. Now, we are called to be rooted in the Lord & His Word. When we are rooted in His Word, we will notice changes in the way we talk to one another. Even the way we look at Jesus & His work in our lives, changes. Then, God will allow someone to notice Him in you and that he or she exclaims, "I want what you have." And you will reply, "I have Jesus only. Take Him!" Your life is on its way to become a Mission-Story.

### **Conclusion**

Since Easter is around the corner, let's continue to remain in Jesus. If we are in tune with Jesus and His Word, we will encounter Him in our daily walk. On some days our stories could be huge, and, on some days, it is small but still, it is yours and my story. We need to be rooted in the Lord, be empowered by the Holy Spirit, to remain in Jesus, to be "plugged in" to Jesus so that we are not limited to love Jesus and His story in our lives.
