Eternal life with God cannot be earned or won, and those who refuse to accept it as a gift can never receive.

REFLECTION: How am I responding to the many gifts that God has given me? When do I find it difficult to live out the spirit of the Beatitudes in my life? What are the things of the world that fill my heart, preventing me from receiving the fullness of God's gifts?
